“Stand and Deliver” tells the story of a high school mathematics teacher who takes a class of potential dropouts and transforms them, in the course of one school year, into kids who have learned so much that 18 of them are able to pass a tough college credit calculus exam. The exam

is so hard that only 2 percent of students nationwide can pass it, although everyone in this class does. The true story of an inspirational teacher (Edward James Olmos) and the East Los Angeles high school students who he motivates to learn calculus.
